We are formed for the family of God. We seek to serve together, grow together and live life together with a common vision.




















FROM PASTOR JUSTIN JACOBS

We just finished the month of August and as I sit back and reflect on the year thus far, I am left in utter amazement at what God has done not only in our church but through our church this year. We just had our 3rd in -person Sunday Morning Service after almost 6 months of only online broadcasts and God is moving. Our Governor mandated

regulations that made it impossible for us to gather as the body of Christ and worship in-person. He deemed pot dispensaries, casinos, liquor stores, Abortion clinics and other establishments "essential" while deeming churches and houses of worship non-essential. We complied and honored authority and even as more and more data came in that showed that the risk of COVID was next to nothing, we still complied and honored state and federal guidelines for the safety of our congregation and before the Lord.

From the beginning we prayed and sought the Lord for wisdom as we navigated these uncharted waters. As we prayed, searched the scriptures and sought legal council we concluded that as soon as we had a place to meet in person, we would again come together and exercise our constitutional right to gather and worship OUR GOD! As the Body of Christ we needed to stand!

NEW SANTA MARIA CAMPUS All of 2019 we grew as a church body and were in constant prayer for a new larger facility to accomodate future growth and expansion. We looked throughout Nipomo and could not find another facility. We set our sights on another venue at Pioneer High School in North Santa Maria and began making plans and believing God to make a way for us to move into that. BUT, just as the Word says, ("Man plans his ways but the Lord directs his steps." -Proverbs 16:9) God had a different plan for us. Not only would He provide us a larger facility, but He would grow our family, unite us with another church, build us a brand new building, and give us an even greater opportunity for growth and impact in this region. God brought us together with Hope Community Church in Santa Maria with Pastor Phil and Sheri May. As our church was growing, Pastor Phil asked if we would take their church over and continue in their heart to reach Santa Maria and this region for Jesus. After much prayer and council we accepted and now have a New Bridge Central Coast Campus on Skyway Dr.. in Santa Maria. In May our leadership team began coming alongside Hope's leadership team and building the foundation we would need to fully come together at the end of the summer. It has been such an honor and a priviledge working with everyone here at Hope Community and I am proud and so blessed to say that on September 1, 2020 we officially became one body as The Bridge Central Coast.

This merging of our two bodies has been super natural. We have the same heart and passion for people and to see God move mightily not only in our cities but in this region. We have gained new team members and it is our belief that God has handpicked this leadership team for such a time as this. Already, we have seen God's favor and hand upon our ministry and in just the past few weeks, and finally, after 6 months of doing church online only, we opened for our first in-person Sunday Morning Service on Aug 23rd and had 180 adults and 40 kids. God is moving and I am more confident than ever, "The best is yet to come."

The numbers below represent the costs associated with the new building. Hope Community had \$100k set aside in a designated building fund to begin construction on the new building but we needed an additional almost \$150k to finish construction and set it up so that we could once again meet and gather for worship. We have taken a loan for the additional almost \$150k in faith and need your help so that we can continue to faithfully pay that off in the days ahead. If you call The Bridge Central Coast your home church then I would ask you to please pray and ask the Lord for what He would have you give, above and beyond your normal tithes and offerings as a seed offering into our new building and campus. Whatever it is, know that God will honor it and know that you are partnering with us in continuing to reach and impact the lost and broken in our local community and around the world for Jesus Christ. Love you guys and so thankful for your continued prayer, support, and generous partnership with us here at The Bridge Central Coast.
